

SHORELINE TEAM TENNIS

CAPTAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Prior to each match (at least one or two days before), the home captain or the co-captain should call the visiting team captain to confirm that the match will be played and to ensure that the directions to the courts are clear.
2. Host teams must supply a new can of USTA approved balls for each match.
3. In case of unplayable or unsafe weather (rain, heat index 110 degrees or higher), captains must decide whether to move matches inside. Both captains should agree. However, if they do not agree, the home team captain will make the decision. The home team captain is responsible for securing back-up indoor courts, for which both teams shall pay. If the home team does not have access to indoor courts, the visiting team may provide them if possible.
4. Before match play begins, captains should fill out a score sheet, clarify court rules and clarify Shoreline League Rules. In the spirit of having fun, competitive matches, captains have the responsibility of using eligible players of the appropriate ability for the level of play in their respective divisions.
5. For time-limited matches, the captains should call together their teams and synchronize their watches before match play begins. All players should be aware of the time and should follow the scoring as described in Rules and Regulations 3-G-5.
6. The team captains are responsible for completion of the score sheets. Both team captains must sign each team's score sheet at the conclusion of the match. **The winning team must mail or fax their score sheet to the league coordinator.**
